### What is the 2020 Census Timeline?

- Now-end of April, in to May: encourage people to fill out their census information.
- March 12-20, 2020: households receive invitation to respond to census online; can also respond by phone or, later, by mail (mid-April)
- My2020census.gov
- UW dorms were to be April 6<sup>th</sup> . . .

### What is the 2020 Census Timeline?

- Late March 2020: Enumeration of nonsheltered outdoor locations (people experiencing homelessness)
- March-April 2020: Reminder letters, postcards
- April 1, 2020: Census day!
- May-July 2020: Census staff person visits non-responding addresses ("Nonresponse Follow-Up"). Census ends 7/31/20.



## What is the 2020 Census Timeline?

- November 2020: Data processing and tabulation.
- December 2020: Bureau reports state population totals and resulting congressional apportionment.
- Spring 2021: Bureau begins releasing detailed population data for cities (used in Council redistricting)


- How many people live in household
