TO: Property Owners along Rethke Avenue

RE: Project 12693 Proposed Street Reconstruction Project & Public Hearing

The City of Madison is proposing the reconstruction of Rethke Avenue from East Washington Avenue to Commercial Avenue in 2020. Enclosed with this is a fact sheet with some details on the proposed project along with a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works. The date, time and location of the public hearing can be found on the notification.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. The property owners will be assessed for various items included with this proposed project. The costs of some items are shared between the property owner and the City, while other costs are assessed entirely to the property owner. A table detailing the City's standard assessment policy for these items is included in the fact sheet.

Also enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the property owner's share of estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed after the completion of the project, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3.0 % interest charged on the unpaid balance.

That the City Engineer has prepared plans, specifications, a proposed schedule of assessments, and an estimate of the entire costs of the improvement for each of the districts listed in Part II hereof, and;

That the plans, specifications, a proposed schedule of assessments, and an estimate of the entire cost of the improvements listed hereto are available and open to inspection by all interested persons in the office of the City Engineer, Room 115, City-County Building, 210 Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and will so continue to be for ten (10) working days from the first published date of this notice, and;

That on <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>MARCH 25</u>, 2020 AT 5:30 P.M., the Board of Public Works will hold a public hearing in <u>ROOM 108 (PARKS CONFERENCE ROOM)</u> OF THE CITY COUNTY BUILDING and will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus three (3%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.

Project Details - Proposed Work

Sanitary Sewer: Replace the existing sewer mains with new PVC pipes and replace laterals from the new main to the property line.

Storm Sewer: Replace existing sewer mains, inlets and access structures that are in poor condition. Reconnect private storm sewer laterals to new sewer systems. Install new storm sewer laterals if requested by the property owner.

Water Main: Will not be replaced with this reconstruction project.

Street: Replace the entire existing asphalt pavement within the project limits, spot replace existing sidewalk, curb, and gutter that are in poor condition or as necessary to replace the sanitary sewer lateral. Install new sidewalk, driveway aprons, curb, and gutter on both sides of the street where there is none currently.

Trees: No trees will be removed with the reconstruction project.

Terrace Areas: Will be disturbed completely on both sides of the street for the replacement and installation of sidewalk, driveway aprons, curb, gutter, and sewer laterals.

Bus Pad: Not Applicable

Assessments: After construction is complete, the assessments are recalculated based on the bid prices and measured quantities. The final assessments are mailed in the summer of 2021. Property owners can pay the assessments in a lump sum or over 8 years with 3% interest.

Construction Schedule & Impacts

Tentative Schedule: This project is scheduled to be bid in April 2020. Construction is expected to begin in June 2020 and be finished in September 2020.

Traffic Impacts: Traffic will remain open only for residents and business customers and staff. Access to properties within the project limits will remain available at all times with brief interruptions.



Supplemental Forestry Information

Tree pruning in advance of the project is required to reduce the risk of damage to the trees during construction.

The City of Madison Forestry Section will perform the necessary work. For certain species, especially oak and elm trees, the pruning must be completed by April 1 to reduce the chance of disease. If additional trees need to be removed, City Engineering will notify the adjacent property owner prior to removal. Street trees provide many benefits to our city and are considered an important part of the city's infrastructure. Forestry Section staff will evaluate the terrace for new planting sites and potential replacement sites when the project is complete. There is no additional cost to the adjacent property owner for a tree planting. Street trees are typically planted in the spring of the year following the completion of the construction project. Per Madison General Ordinance 10.10, City Forestry determines tree species and planting locations. Residents cannot choose or plant their own tree in the terrace.
