Draft Historic Preservation Plan Adopting Resolution

Title:

A Resolution adopting the Historic Preservation Plan as a supplement to the Comprehensive Plan, directing staff to implement the recommendations contained in the plan, **accepting the *Underrepresented Communities Historic Resource Survey Report***, and dissolving the Historic Preservation Plan Advisory Committee.

Fiscal Note:

No additional City appropriation is required with the adoption of the Historic Preservation Plan. However, implementing recommendations within the Plan will require additional staff and/or consultant resources. These expenditures, as well as others, will need to be included in future capital and operating budgets, subject to Common Council approval at that time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the *Underrepresented Communities Historic Resource Survey Report* is hereby accepted and may be administratively updated as new historic resources and other information is discovered; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Common Council expresses its appreciation to members of the Historic Preservation Plan Advisory Committee for contributing their time and expertise to this important effort and hereby dissolves the Committee.
