








Unemployment expected to remain above 6% through 2023

U.S. gross domestic product, change from prior quarter. Data for the second quarter of 2020 is a projection from the Atlanta Fed.






Difference in Real Gross Domestic Product Between CBO's May 2020 and January 2020 Projections





Continued Claims have Declined for Six Straight Weeks




Initial Unemployment Claims Continue to Fall





Dane County, Milwaukee County, Rest of State Claims as Share of Population




Some Growth in Air Travel (approaching 15% of last year, up from 10% of last year in April)
