Neighbors understand the outdoor patio will be permitted under the Streatery program and that for 2020 the capacity inside and outside is 50 total, not 50 in/50 out. Neighbors expect to discuss the outdoor service area again through the formal conditional use process in 2021. I would request that you grant only the 50 indoor seats and not grant 50 outdoor seats so we can discuss setting official outdoor capacity next year.
