Dear Mr. Stoffregan;

The one-lot Certified Survey Map of property generally addressed as 6003-6051 Gemini Drive, Section 11, Township 7N, Range 10E, City of Madison, Dane County, Wisconsin, is hereby **conditionally approved**. The property is zoned PD. The conditions of approval from the reviewing agencies to be satisfied prior to final approval and recording of the CSM are:

Please contact Brenda Stanley of the City Engineering Division at 261-9127 if you have questions regarding the following four (4) items:

- 1. Enter into a City / Developer agreement for the required infrastructure improvements. The agreement shall be executed prior to sign off. Allow 4-6 weeks to obtain agreement. Contact the City Engineering Division to schedule the development and approval of the plans and the agreement.
- 2. Make sidewalk, roadway, curb and gutter, and parking and terrace improvements as required by City Engineer.
- 3. A minimum of two (2) working days prior to requesting City Engineering signoff on the CSM, contact either Tim Troester (West) at 261-1995 (ttroester@cityofmadison.com) or Brenda Stanley (East) at 261-9127 (bstanley@cityofmadison.com) to obtain the final stormwater utility charges that are due and payable prior to sub-division of the properties. The stormwater utility charges (as all utility charges) are due for the previous months of service and must be cleared prior to the land division (and subsequent obsolesces of the existing parcel).
- 4. The applicant shall add the following note to the CSM: "This lot is responsible for compliance with the requirements of MGO Chapter 37 at the time of development."

Please contact Jeff Quamme of the City Engineering Division–Mapping Section at 266-4097 if you have questions regarding the following eight (8) items:

- 5. The pending Certified Survey Map application for this property shall be completed and recorded with the Dane County Register of Deeds (ROD), the new parcel data created by the Assessor's Office and the parcel data available to Zoning and Building Inspection staff prior to issuance of building permits for new construction.
- 6. The portion of the Public Sanitary Sewer Easement per Grandview Commons Replat No. 3 that is intended to be released shall be released by separate document prepared by City Office of Real Estate Services. Contact Jeff Quamme of Engineering Mapping (irquamme@cityofmadison.com, 608-266-4097) to coordinate the Real Estate project, and associated information and fees required. If any release is required prior to recording of the plat, acknowledgement of the release and document number shall be noted on the face of the plat.
- 7. It has been noted that there is an underground communications line along the west side of this CSM that is not within an easement of record per the site plans of the proposed development. Coordinate and request from the utility companies any easements required to serve this development. Those easements shall be properly shown, dimensioned and labeled on the final Certified Survey Map.
- 8. The 25-foot Access Easement for the benefit of current Lot 1013 per the plat of Grandview Commons Replat No. 3 shall be released prior to final sign off. The Declaration of Easements Covenants and Restrictions for Grandview Commons Replat No. 3 per Document 5246564 shall be amended or released and a new Declaration of Easements Covenants and Restrictions shall be drafted to accommodate the development as proposed. Provide a copy for review prior to sign off of the Certified Survey Map. The agreement shall be recorded after the Certified Survey Map has been recorded.
- 9. Remove Notes 2(A) and 2(J) on sheet 3. Those documents have been released or terminated by Document No 5246564.
- 10. Wisconsin Administrative Code A-E 7.08 identifies when Public Land System (PLS) tie sheets must be filed with the Dane County Surveyor's office. The Developer's Surveyor and/or Applicant must submit copies of required tie sheets or monument condition reports (with current tie sheet attached) for all monuments, including center of sections of record, used in this survey, to Jeff Quamme, City Engineering (irquamme@cityofmadison.com).
- 11. Prior to Engineering final sign-off by main office for Certified Survey Maps, the final CSM shall be submitted in PDF format by email transmittal to Engineering Land Records Coordinator Jeff Quamme (jrquamme@cityofmadison.com) for final technical review and approval. This submittal must occur a minimum of two working days prior to final Engineering Division sign-off.
- 12. The applicant shall submit to Jeff Quamme, prior to final Engineering sign-off of the subject CSM, one (1) digital CADD drawing in a format compatible with AutoCAD. The digital CADD file(s) shall be referenced to the Dane County Coordinate System and shall contain, at minimum, the list of items stated below, each on a separate layer/level name. The line work shall be void of gaps and overlaps and match the final recorded CSM: right of way lines (public and private); lot lines; lot numbers;

lot/plat dimensions; street names, and; easement lines (including wetland and floodplain boundaries).

*This transmittal is a separate requirement than the required submittals to Engineering Streets Section for design purposes. The Developer/Surveyor shall submit new updated final plat, electronic data and a written notification to Engineering Mapping for any changes to the plat which occur subsequent to any submittal.

13. The developer shall provide a recorded copy of any joint driveway ingress/egress and crossing easements and shall be noted on face of plan.

Please contact Jeff Belshaw of the Traffic Engineering Division at 261-9835 if you have any questions regarding the following two (2) items:

- 14. The water service to 6067 Gemini maybe in conflict with the CSM where as it crosses the proposed property line of new CSM. See comments below. Upon development, a separate water service lateral and water meter will be required to serve each parcel. The water laterals shall be directly connected to the public water main with the shut-off valve located in the public right-of-way (per PSC 185.52 (2)). A water lateral is not required if the parcel remains undeveloped.
- 15. Madison Water Utility will be required to sign off as part of the approval review associated with this Land Use Application/Site Plan Review prior to the issuance of building permits for the proposed development.

Please contact Ann Freiwald of the Traffic Engineering Division at 243-2848 if you have any questions regarding the following three (3) items:

- 16. Park Impact Fees (comprised of the Park Infrastructure Impact Fee, per MGO Sec. 20.08(2)), and Park-Land Impact Fees, per MGO Sec. 16.23(8)(f) and 20.08(2) will be required for all new residential development associated with this project. This development is within the East Park-Infrastructure Impact Fee district. Please reference ID# 14136.2 when contacting Parks Division staff about this project.
- 17. Prior to sign off on the CSM the applicant shall execute a declaration of conditions and covenants for impact fees.
- 18. The following note should be included on the CSM: "Lots within this subdivision are subject to impact fees that are due and payable at the time building permit(s) are issued." The Parks Division shall be required to sign off on this CSM.

Please contact Lance Vest of the Office of Real Estate Services at 245-5794 if you have any questions regarding the following seven (7) items:

- 19. Signature block certifications shall be executed by all parties of interest having the legal authority to do so, pursuant to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2)(a). The title of each certificate shall be consistent with the ownership interest reported in the most recent title report. The executed original hard stock recordable CSM shall be presented at the time of sign-off.
- 20. A certificate of consent for all mortgagees/vendors shall be included following the Owner's Certificate(s) and executed prior to CSM approval sign-off.
- 21. All ownership consents and certifications for the subject lands shall conform to Wis. Stats. 236.21(2) and 236.29 by including the language "...surveyed, divided, mapped and <u>dedicated</u>..."
- 22. As of July 24, 2020, the 2019 real estate taxes remain due for the subject property. Per 236.21(3) Wis. Stats. and MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)(1), the property owner shall pay all real estate taxes that are accrued or delinquent for the subject property prior to CSM recording.
- 23. As of July 24, 2020, there are no special assessments reported. All known special assessments are due and payable prior to CSM approval sign-off. If special assessments are levied against the property during the review period and prior to CSM approval sign-off, they shall be paid in full pursuant to MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)1. In lieu of this requirement, the owner may present written documentation from the City's Board of Public Works that the special assessments may be continued to be paid on the installment basis authorized by the Board of Public Works. However, if lands within the CSM boundary are to be dedicated, the special assessments levied against the dedicated lands are to be paid in full.
- 24. Pursuant to MGO Section 16.23(5)(g)(4), the owner shall furnish an updated title report to Lance Vest in City's Office of Real Estate Services (lvest@cityofmadison.com), as well as the survey firm preparing the proposed CSM. The report shall search the period subsequent to the date of the initial title report (May 1, 2020) submitted with the CSM application and include all associated documents that have been recorded since the initial title report. A title commitment may be provided, but will be considered only as supplementary information to the title report update. The surveyor shall update the CSM with the most recent information reported in the title update.
- 25. Revise the CSM as follows prior to final approval and recording:
 - a.) Depict, name, and identify by document number all existing easements cited in record title and the updated title report. In particular, the easements recorded as Document Nos. 3236045, 3709551, 3906455, 4362638, and 5246564.
 - b.) Include a reference to the agreement recorded as Document No. 4494260.
 - c.) Include reference to the Declaration of Restrictive Covenants recorded as Document No. 4391269.
 - d.) Correct the reference to Document No. 4458043 in Note 2.c.
 - e.) Coordinate the release of the portion of the Public Sanitary Sewer Easement per Grandview Commons Replat No. 3 that is intended to be released with the Office of Real Estate Services.

- f.) Depict and dimension all existing improvements including, but not limited to: buildings, drives, parking lots, encroachments, wells, septic systems, etc. located within the CSM boundary.
- g.) If all parties of interest agree that certain easements from prior plats or CSM's of record are no longer necessary, the release documents for said easements shall be recorded prior to CSM approval sign-off, with the recording information for the release included as a Note on the proposed CSM.

Specific questions regarding the comments or conditions contained in this letter should be directed to the commenting agency.

A resolution approving the CSM and authorizing the City to sign it and any other documents related to the proposed land division was approved by the Common Council at its September 1, 2020 meeting.

Approval of this Certified Survey Map does not include any approval to construct new buildings on the subject site. A letter with the conditions of approval for the related development of the site will be sent separately.

In order to commence the process for obtaining the necessary City signatures on the Certified Survey Map, the applicant shall e-mail the revised CSM, updated title report, and any other materials required by reviewing agencies to the reviewing planner. The reviewing planner will share the updated materials with the relevant commenting City agencies for them to verify that their conditions have been satisfied and that the secretary or designee may sign the Plan Commission approval certificate. Once the Plan Commission certificate is executed, the Planning Division will transmit the CSM to the City Clerk's Office for execution of the Common Council certificate.

Once all of the necessary City signatures have been affixed to the Certified Survey Map, the instrument will be returned electronically to the applicant by the Planning Division for printing and recording at the Dane County Register of Deeds Office. For information on recording procedures and fees, please contact the Register of Deeds at 266-4141.

Any appeal from this action, including the conditions of approval, must be filed with the Circuit Court within 30 days from the date of this letter. The approval of this CSM shall be null and void if not recorded in twelve (12) months from the date of the approving resolution or this letter, whichever is later.
