

- Highest BCycle utilization rate in the country


#### 2020




#### **Other Trends:**




#### **Other Trends:**

- Member trips nearly split between Annual (39%) and Monthly (35%); Casual trips 26%







Rider Trips by Membership Type
















# Madison BCycle provides riders with a safe, healthy and socially distant mode of transit and recreation.


