Dear Fadi El Musa,

I wasn't able to attend the public meeting for the reconstruction project of Dunning and Jackson St.

I hope that I can make a couple suggestions that will be added to the public comment notes.

They are:

1) Please consider adding a stop sign, speed bump, or roundabout at some intersections (like at Dunning and Bashford). People use Dunning as a cutthrough street and speed quite fast on it. I'd like this fast, non-resident driving behavior to be reduced. Stop signs or bumps might help. Little roundabouts on LaFollette would be helpful, too.

2) Please don't widen LaFollette or the other streets involved. Wider streets cause faster traffic and less permeable terrace land for trees.

3) Please don't add street lights at the dead-end of Dunning St. It is a nice tranquil, and wooded, dead end and gets enough ambient light from neighboring street lighting. No need to add to light pollution in the area.
