Background

- 2020 has been a year of profound change and challenges with the Country's racial reckoning and the public health and economic impacts of COVID-19
- As such, for 2021, staff has proposed the repurposing of funds set to be freshly appropriated in 2021 and future years into an umbrella fund supporting community food systems investments in a variety of ways



Background (Con.)

- The expected legislative timeline* for adoption/creation of the Healthy Community Food Systems Fund and funding is:
 - Intro w/o debate at 11/17 Common Council
 - Adoption at 12/1 Common Council
 - Program guidelines proposed, discussed and adopted at 12/7 MFPC-DCFC meeting

*revised after motion passage at 11/2 MFPC meeting



Components and Funding Sources

\$268k in total proposed funding for the creation of the Healthy Community Food Systems Fund

- 1. Community Food Access Competitive Grants Program
 - a. \$50k from 2021 SEED Grants
 - b. \$100k from FY18/FY20 Healthy Retail Access Program
- 2. Rapid Food Access and Food Entrepreneur Support Program
 - a. \$100k from FY18/FY20 Healthy Retail Access Program
- 3. Regional Food Systems Planning Process Support
 - a. \$18k total from FY18/FY20 Healthy Retail Access Program
