Background

In 2018, PHMDC reassigned 2 positions to violence prevention

- Educated partners and community on public health approach to violence prevention
- Established new strategic partnerships in order to build understanding of current violence prevention
- Formulated key partnerships needed for data infrastructure

PHMDC has worked to jump start some violence prevention initiatives

- Convened inaugural violence prevention coalition meeting
- Community Safety Intervention Team (CSIT)
- Conducted community and police listening circles



Where We Are Today

Revitalized CSIT to better support how the group analyzes violent incidents and trends

- Purpose: to identify individuals and groups at greatest risk for being shot or for pulling the trigger
- Worked with this group to establish needs in order to make the largest impact (Data, Format, Database, Mapping, IAS)

Past 4 months have been used to develop the Roadmap to Reducing Violence (working title)

 Comprehensive plan that identifies five key areas of work for Madison and Dane County




Strengthen Community Capacity, Engagement, and Coordination of Violence Prevention Efforts

Activity examples:

- Enhance local capacity to access, analyze, and utilize violence-related data from variety of sources.
- CSIT
- Increase coordination of mental health and trauma services across agencies to support children, youth and families exposed to multiple forms of violence.
- Explore a community safety worker pilot that aids communities in conflict resolution and deters law enforcement involvement from low level conflict.
- Explore group intervention model

Next Steps


Violence Prevention Unit

- Requesting position authority for the two new positions through Dane County
- Planning for the next Violence Prevention Coalition of Dane County meeting (aiming for January/February 2021)
- Improving our data infrastructure to aid be more forward facing to allow for the public and stakeholders to be more informed about violence in Madison

Roadmap to Reduction

- Community and Stakeholder Feedback will begin later this week
- Feedback will be incorporated and further recommendations will be developed in December 2020/January 2021
- Developing RFP funding opportunity to support elements of the plan in conjunction with CDD
- Roadmap to Reduction is currently on track for release and implementation kick off in January 2021
