




Proposed Site Plan











Lower Level Plan





First Floor Plan








Building Height – Isometric








Building Height – Thru N. Lake St











Building Height – Thru Mendota Ct


















Historic Property Jurisdiction

- Neither house is located within a City of Madison Local Historic District or considered a landmark, subject to Landmarks Commission land use jurisdiction¹
- National Historic Districts exist as a financing tool to allow tax incentives for property repairs, and these properties fall within one such district
- Although some local districts are also listed in the National Register, the program requirements of the two programs are not the same and there are differences in boundaries.
- The major effect of listing on the National Register is financial incentives in the form of two kinds of tax credits; one for the rehabilitation of income-producing property and one for the rehabilitation of single-family residences²
 - As a non-profit, Alpha Chi Sigma does not qualify for federal or State of Wisconsin Historic Tax Credits


