Re: Madison Children's Museum – Letter of Intent

100 N. Hamilton Street

Dear Colin:

This is our Letter of Intent for the property located at 100 N. Hamilton Street. The owner, Madison Children's Museum, Inc., is planning to demolish the existing one-story parking structure and associated loading area on the north side that runs along East Dayton Street. That structure will largely be replaced with on-grade exhibit space and a rebuilt loading area to serve the existing museum.

<u>Scope of Demolition / Renovation:</u>

- Remove existing parking structure, slab on grade, trash enclosure and loading area. The existing structure is beyond its functional life and no longer safe for use.
- New perimeter fence and gate system above the existing retaining walls.
- 11,322 sf lower level is programed to be a mix of exhibit zones, new bathrooms, storage and egress components. The log cabin will be relocated to be a feature element on the corner while the other exhibits will likely evolve or the years.
- 2,779 sf of elevated loading area that contains handicap parking, bike parking, trash enclosure and egress paths. The size and configuration is similar to the existing condition.
- Existing arched pole lighting is to remain with no additional fixtures being added that can be seen by the public.
