## **SUMMARY:**

Bailey said that staff recommends a finding of no known historic value for this building, as there is no preservation file or Wisconsin Historical Society site file. Andrzejewski recently walked by the house and said that from a distance, it appeared there have been a lot of changes to the house over time that would affect its integrity, such as replacement windows, changing the window openings, and a rear addition. She said that the building's condition also appeared to be deteriorated. She mentioned that while not part of their jurisdiction, the West Lawn neighborhood is a part of Madison that doesn't have a lot of infill.
