
History of the Property

- Constructed 1927
 - Henry & Bessie Davis House
- French Provincial style
 - High pitched, hipped roof
 - Stucco & wood
 - Multi-light windows & shutters



Proposed Work

- Replace beams and modify window openings in front entry
- Modify window openings in kitchen
- Replace rear balcony door with window to match adjacent
- Replace nonhistoric bay window on rear with period-appropriate windows to match existing elsewhere one structure

- (g) Additions and Exterior Alterations Not Visible from the Street.
























Staff Recommendation
