#### **Athletics Fees**

- Space Type
- Prep work
  - ▶ Charged if reservation is under a certain amount of time.
- Lights
  - ▶ Differ based on light type
- Permits
  - ► Alcohol, Amplified Sound, Temporary Structure
  - ▶ Permit requests often lead to special event process


### Athletic Fees - History

- 2016 Parks took steps to standardize athletics
  - Paper applications, fees standardized by space type instead of usage
  - ▶ Allowed for more consistent billing and data relating to reservations
  - ► This standard fee structure exists today
    - ▶ 2-3% fee increase every 2 years since 2016
- ▶ 2018 Implemented online reservation system and youth fee structure

#### Youth Athletics Fees

- Prior to 2018
  - Youth athletics not charged for reservations of athletic spaces.
  - Some were charged for add-ons like field prep and lights, but fees were inconsistent
- Starting in 2018
  - As approved by Board of Park Commissioners, youth athletic reservations charged 40% of standard reservation rate
    - Ex. Standard soccer field reservations are \$25/hour, standard youth athletic users pay \$10/hour

#### Future directions

- More agreements/fee modifications
  - Agreements/fee mods are not currently offered to all users, but instead offered when requested and when staff sees opportunity for equity and better relationships with users
    - ► Large volume users have traditionally been granted agreements/fee modifications more often than small volume users
- Standard fees with qualified discounts to replace some or all agreements/fee modifications
  - Cost to user
  - For profit v non-profit/not for profit
  - Community benefit
  - Scholarship rates
    - Provides modifications to fees without agreements/fee modifications. Volume not necessarily a consideration
