



Redistricting

- Process of redrawing wards and aldermanic districts (ADs)
- Boundaries adjusted based on population change between 2010 and 2020 Census
- Equalize population within each AD
- Redistricting will take place at the city, county and state level

 - Aldermanic District Plan

2011 Written Criteria

- 1. Contain an equal number of inhabitants
- 2. Be comprised of contiguous whole wards
- 3. Be compact
- 4. Enhance participation of diverse residents (race/ethnicity/language) in the political process and their ability to elect representatives of their choice
- 5. Contain within them communities of interest (COIs)
- 6. Use major arterials and other physical barriers as boundaries
- 7. Increase the number of districts exposed to future growth
