Bailey said that the third party window assessment previously submitted was lacking sufficient detail to make a determination about which windows were salvageable versus needing replacement. She said the third party assessor did recommend replacement of the windows because they were deteriorated beyond repair. The Landmarks Commission had requested more detailed information on the condition of each window and the cost of repair. She said that she received a little more information from the third party assessor, but not necessarily what the commission requested. She said that the applicants have followed the process in good faith. She pointed out that the existing windows are not particularly distinctive and the building has undergone extensive changes over time. She said that the property owner has endeavored to comply with the window replacement process established by the commission and the third party assessment recommends replacement, so staff recommends approval of the project as proposed.
