### Heather-

We reviewed the Agenda and supporting materials on Legistar for the LC meeting tomorrow and have the following concerns:

-We issued the owner's evaluation report to Heather Bailey in January in a draft form and on 02.10.21 as a final form to be included as material for the LC meeting. -See notes regarding this in the correspondence below -The issued report report was NOT included in the LC 02.15.2021 Agenda materials for Agenda item 63346 and we don't know why it wasn't. (See attached .pdf of attachments for the 02.15.2021 meeting)

The Staff report (attached) states that <u>both</u> reports were included for member's review. This is not correct. Our analysis was NOT included. Proposed concept plans were included, but not the revised analysis.

Archetype's report WAS included, which is again very odd, because we specifically noted to Heather Bailey that we were including Archetype's report in ours and commenting on it.

This is the second time that the Owner's evaluation was not included in the LC agenda materials and we can't understand why.

We are assuming that it wasn't intentional to specifically exclude this information from the meeting agenda attachment materials on two separate occasions for this site.

We are requesting that the attached summary be included in the agenda attachments for review by LC members.

Alder Verveer: Can you please provide some input on this- Since our information (disappointingly) does not appear to be available to LC members prior to the day of the meeting,

is it possible to wait until the next LC meeting so Commission members can have an opportunity to review the information we are presenting.

#### Applicant: Christopher Gosch, Populance

**Applicant's Comments**: Resubmittal of this property with a modification to the proposed project and owner is providing additional information on the existing structure.

**Staff Findings**: The preservation file for this property indicates that the vernacular brick house was constructed in 1853 for Gabriel Bjornson. Bjornson served for many years as registrar in probate for the county courts and was a member of the state assembly. In 1902, he was called a "notable Madison Norwegian."

At its October 14, 2019 meeting, the Landmarks Commission found that this property had historic value based upon architectural significance and historic significance, and as a rare remaining resource due to its age. In anticipation of the proposed redevelopment being considered at the Plan Commission, the Madison Trust for Historic Preservation commissioned a study on the property. Their report found that this structure is not eligible to the National or State Registers of Historic Places, but that the property is eligible to be a Madison Landmark under criterion "a" for its association with the settlement and development patterns during the Farwell boom (1846-1856), and criterion "d" as embodying the distinguishing characteristics of an 1850s gabled ell structure The applicant is submitting updated documentation on the historic value of the property for the Landmarks Commission's reconsideration.
