





To: Property Owners along E. Gorham St.
Re: Repairs to improve sidewalk drainage issue

The City of Madison will be resurfacing a portion of E. Gorham St. in 2021. While planning for that project, it was brought our attention that there is a drainage issue along the public sidewalk adjacent to your property, so we are planning to address that issue with the upcoming project. It is expected that portions of the curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveway aprons will need to be replaced in order to improve the drainage issues. Disturbed terrace areas will be restored with topsoil and grass seed.

This project will involve special assessments to the owners of property adjacent to the project. Property owners will be assessed for the replacement of the curb and gutter, driveway aprons, and sidewalk with this proposed project, and the costs to replace these items will be split between the City and property owners on a 50/50 basis. Enclosed is a Schedule of Assessments, which shows the estimated costs for each property adjacent to the project. After the work is complete, a final assessment will be calculated based on bid prices and work actually performed. The final assessment, which will be billed the year following completion of construction, is payable in one lump sum or over a period of 8 years, with 3% interest charged on the unpaid balance.

Also enclosed is a notification for the Public Hearing before the Board of Public Works, which will be held virtually over Zoom. The date and time of the public hearing can be found on the notification, and, once available, links to register for the public hearing can be found at www.cityofmadison.com/clerk.

If you would like instruction on how to participate, please email boardofpublicworks@cityofmadison.com The Board will consider any objections that may be filed in writing or in person and hear all persons desiring to be heard, and;

That special assessments may be paid over an eight (8) year period, with the owner paying 1/8 of the principal each year plus two (2%) percent interest on the unpaid balance, as determined by the Board of Public Works.

That if the total assessment is paid in full before October 31st in the year that the billing is made, irrespective of project completion, then no interest shall be charged.
