SECURITY PLAN FOR LIVE ENTERTAINMENT

Types of Entertainment:

Jordan's Big 10 Pub plans to utilize small bands, DJ's and Karaoke in the bar 1-2 times per month. The live entertainment will be set-up in the corner of the back dining room.

Security Personnel:

For live music events, Jordan's Big 10 Pub will have two or three bouncers on duty depending on the crowd size. One or two will monitor the entrances and check ID's and the other will roam the bar to keep an eye on potential issues and unruly patrons. If a line forms outside, the roaming bouncer will monitor the line. Security personnel attire will be a bright Jordan's Big 10 uniform.

Control and clearance of the parking lot:

Video cameras will be installed inside to provide surveillance for all entrances and exits. Tapes will be made available upon request to the Madison Police Department. The parking lot contains lighting and security personnel and/or Management will periodically patrol the parking lot and exterior of the building.

Unruly Patrons:

Licensee will familiarize the security personnel with provisions of Madison General Ordinances Section 38.06 (10), the unruly patron ordinance. When a patron acts in a manner that is abusive, violent, profane, indecent, boisterous or otherwise disorderly, licensee will immediately contact the Madison Police Department and request that the police invoke the provisions of the ordinance.

Patrons who are intoxicated:

Licensee, its agents and employees may not sell, dispense or give away alcohol to any person who is under the influence of alcoholic beverages as that term is defined in Madison General Ordinances Section 39.02, nor shall such a person be permitted on the premises.

When a patron has been "cut-off", the server will notify the other employees. Management will support the server's decision to terminate service to any patron. If the patron is too impaired to drive safely, licensee will try to persuade the patron not to drive and arrange for a safe ride. If the patron refuses, management will notify the Madison Police Department with the description of the person and the license plate number of the vehicle, if possible.

Patrons Presenting False ID's:

All identification cards used to prove age must be valid (i.e. may not be expired or altered) and must be government issued. If the identification card is expired or appears at all questionable/altered to the Jordan's Big 10 employee, the employee shall request a second form of identification. The employee shall make sure that the individual purchasing the alcohol resembles the picture on the identification card. All employees are encouraged to ask customers questions relating to their identification in order to verify the information. If the employee checking ID's has a strong suspicion that the ID is false, altered or belongs to someone other than the person presenting the ID, he/she shall confiscate the ID and turn it over to Management to be presented to the police.

Control/Supervision of Patrons Under 21 (Restaurant Business):

Licensee will request proof of age from any patron who appears to be 30 years of age or younger and will refuse service to any patron who cannot produce a valid ID. When selling pitchers, an ID will be requested from each patron receiving a glass. Separate types of glassware will be used to distinguish alcohol drinks from non-alcohol drinks.

Circumstances Under Which the Police Will be Called:

The Madison Police Department will be called, in a timely manner, anytime Management or staff has information to believe a crime has been committed and/or whenever a threat of or act of violence occurs on the premises or off premises in areas that would be considered in view or earshot of the establishment.

Handling of Physical Disturbances, Including Fights:

Management or security personnel will ask anyone who is fighting to leave the premises. If necessary, Management or security will call the Madison Police Department for assistance. Licensee will permanently refuse admittance to any chronic problem patrons.
