What is Coordinated Entry?

A process developed to ensure that people experiencing a housing crisis have fair and equal access and are quickly identified, assessed for, referred, and connected to housing and assistance based on their strengths and needs.

How does Coordinated Entry work in Dane County?

Access

- The Beacon
- Emergency shelters
- Outreach programs- Mobile hub
- Tenant Resource Center - Prevention Hub

Assessment & Prioritization

- Prevention for households at risk of homelessness: Dane CoC Prevention Prioritization Tool
- Homeless Services for households residing in shelters or unsheltered locations such as streets, cars, and tents: VI-SPDAT and length of homelessness

Referral & Connection

- To prevention list
- To housing priority lists
- To housing navigation, housing counseling, and other services
