

PSRC Meeting, 06/09/2021

Items of Significance since last meeting:

- Stabbing incident with victim found outside of MFD Station 6 05/30/21
 - Significant injuries and quick actions by MFD personnel likely helped save this individual's life
- Weapons offense incident on Broom near State on 06/03/21
 - Not seeming like a random event and both victims received non-life threatening gunshot wound injuries (stats will be reflected in June crime stats)
 - VCU investigation in progress

Personnel:

- One detective resignation from MPD; four (4) current detective vacancies due to resignations/ retirements/promotions
 - New detective promotional panel effective as of July 1 so promotions are anticipated shortly thereafter
- One officer assigned to Mental Health Unit resigned from MPD; unit will proceed with only five officers for time being
- Five Captains competing in Assistant Chief process
- Five Lieutenants competing in Captain process
 - AC and Captain promotion announcements anticipated early July

- Donated Vacation and Compensatory Time
- Domestic Abuse (draft form on website)

Shots Fired Incidents:

- 19 total incidents in May 2021
 - Two subjects struck by gunfire fired by others in May
 - One attempted homicide victim
 - One road rage victim; one person arrested
 - One accidental discharge
 - Three self-inflicted
- 91 total shots fired incidents in 2021 compared with 70 shots fired incidents at this time in 2020
 - 30% increase this year over last year at this time
 - April percentage was 56.5% increase for 01-04/2021 over 01-04/2020
- 84 casings recovered in May; 254 total in 2021
