The hours of operation for the outdoor eating area requested per this conditional use are proposed by the applicant to be 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. from Monday through Saturday. Staff recommends the addition of a condition noting that changes to the hours of operation for the outdoor eating area can be changed per a minor alteration to the conditional use, if agreed to by the area Alderperson and Director of the Department of Planning, Community, and Economic Development.

## <u>Planning Division Recommendation</u> (Contact Colin Punt, (608) 243-0455)

The Planning Division recommends that the Plan Commission find that the conditional use standards are met and **approve** the request to establish an outdoor eating area at an existing restaurant-tavern at 2302 Packers Avenue. This recommendation is subject to input at the public hearing and the conditions recommended by the Planning Division and other reviewing agencies in the June 21, 2021 report with the following modifications:

That the hours of operation for the rear eating area shall be no later than 10:00 PM daily, after which time
the rear outdoor eating area shall be closed, with no service or seating in the outdoor area after 10:00
PM. In the future, the Director of the Planning Division may consider a minor alteration to the conditional
use to further modify the hours of operation for the outdoor eating and recreation area following a
recommendation by the district alder.
