



Our 7-day average is increasing.


On May 31, it was 12 and on August 2, it was 69.




46,100+ people have tested positive for COVID.




81% of our 12+ population has at least one dose of vaccine.



The last time we met, our 14-day averages looked like this:




It now looks like this:




Hospitalizations



People with Completed Series


People 65+ with 1 Dose





105 mobile clinics40+ vaccination staff1,354 doses given




Mobile Clinics Scheduled




Prioritizing Vaccination & Universal Masking

We issued fall 2021 school guidance.




The guidance recommends a layered approach, combining vaccination and masking with several other strategies.
