

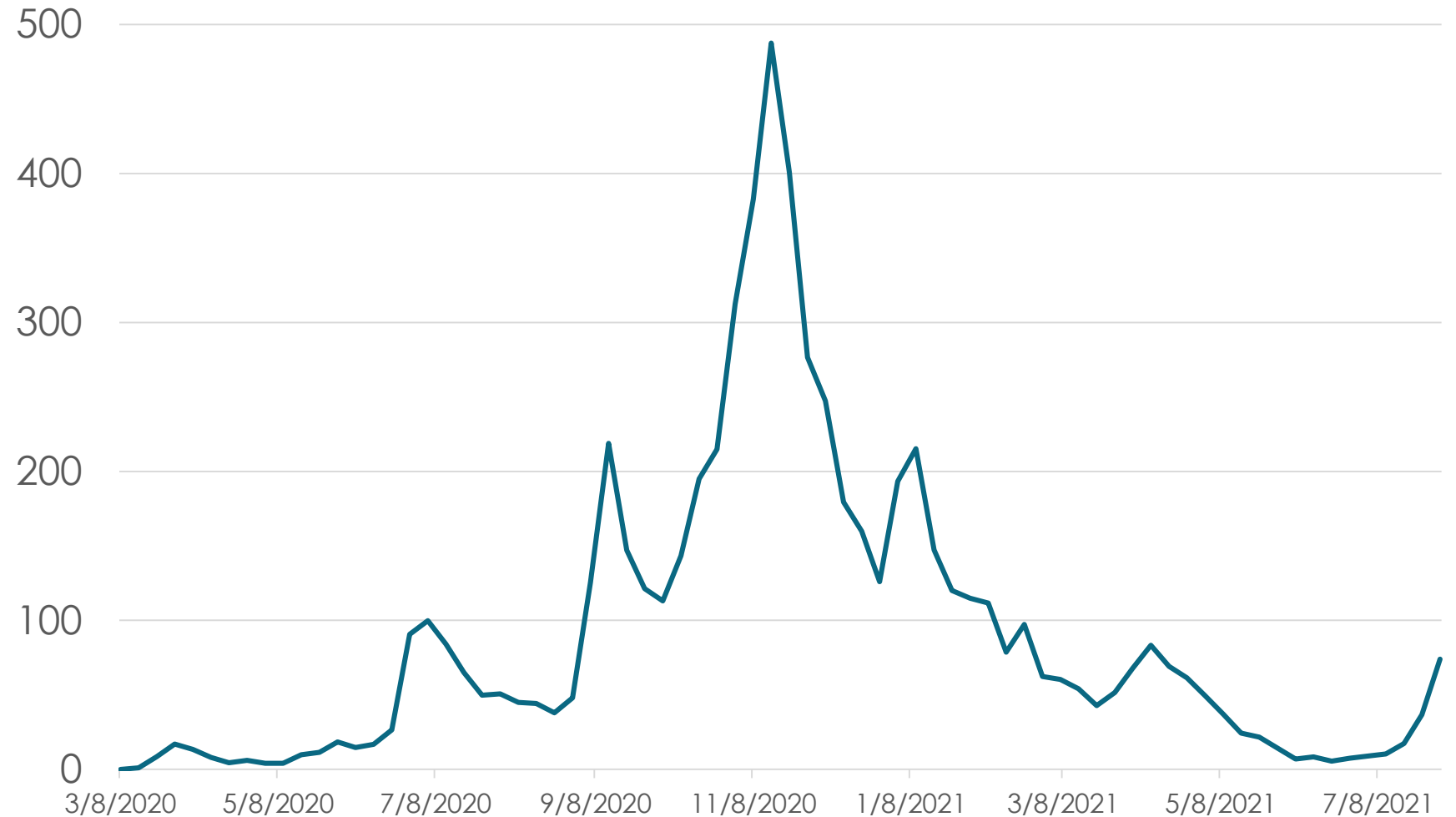

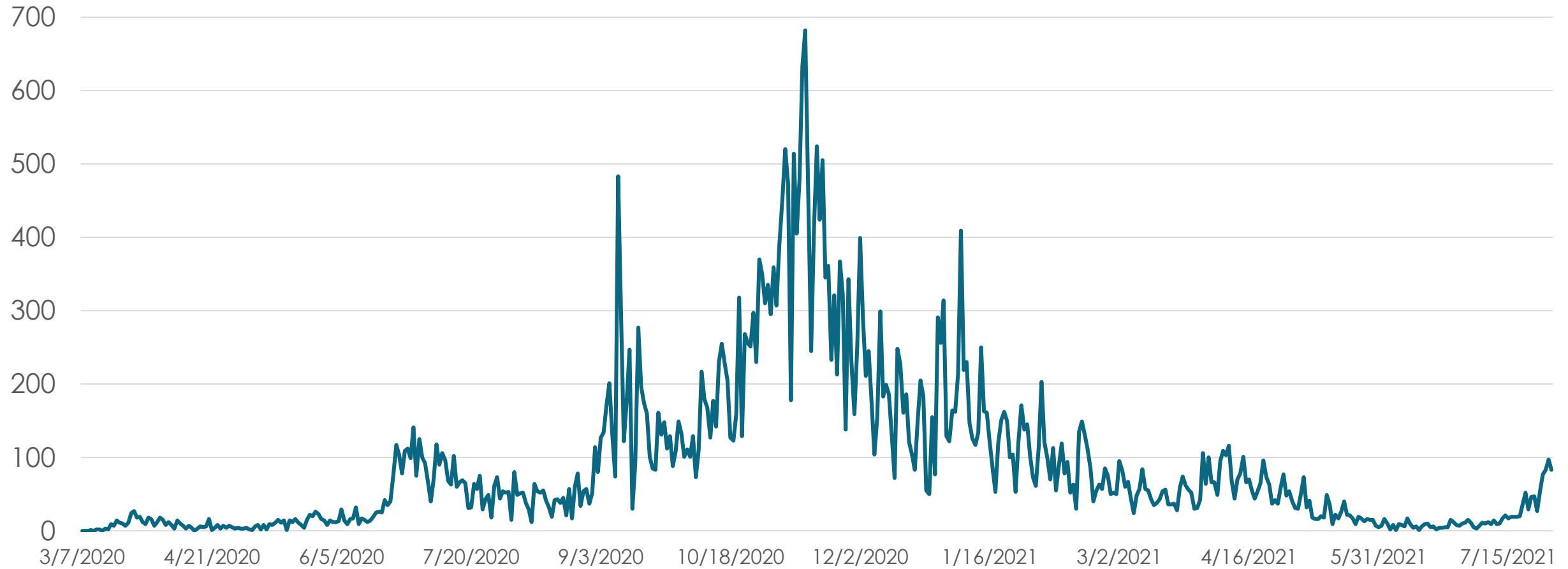

# Our 7-day average is increasing.

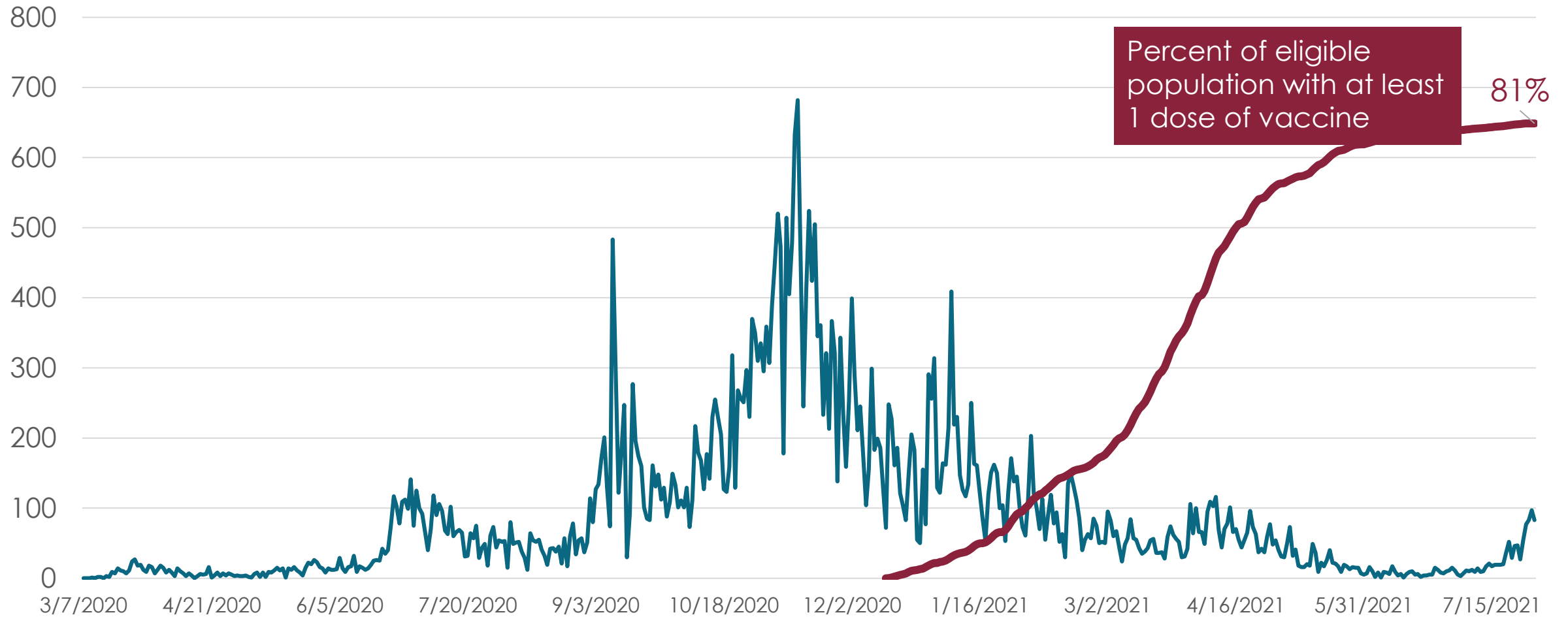
On May 31, it was **12** and on August 2, it was **69**.



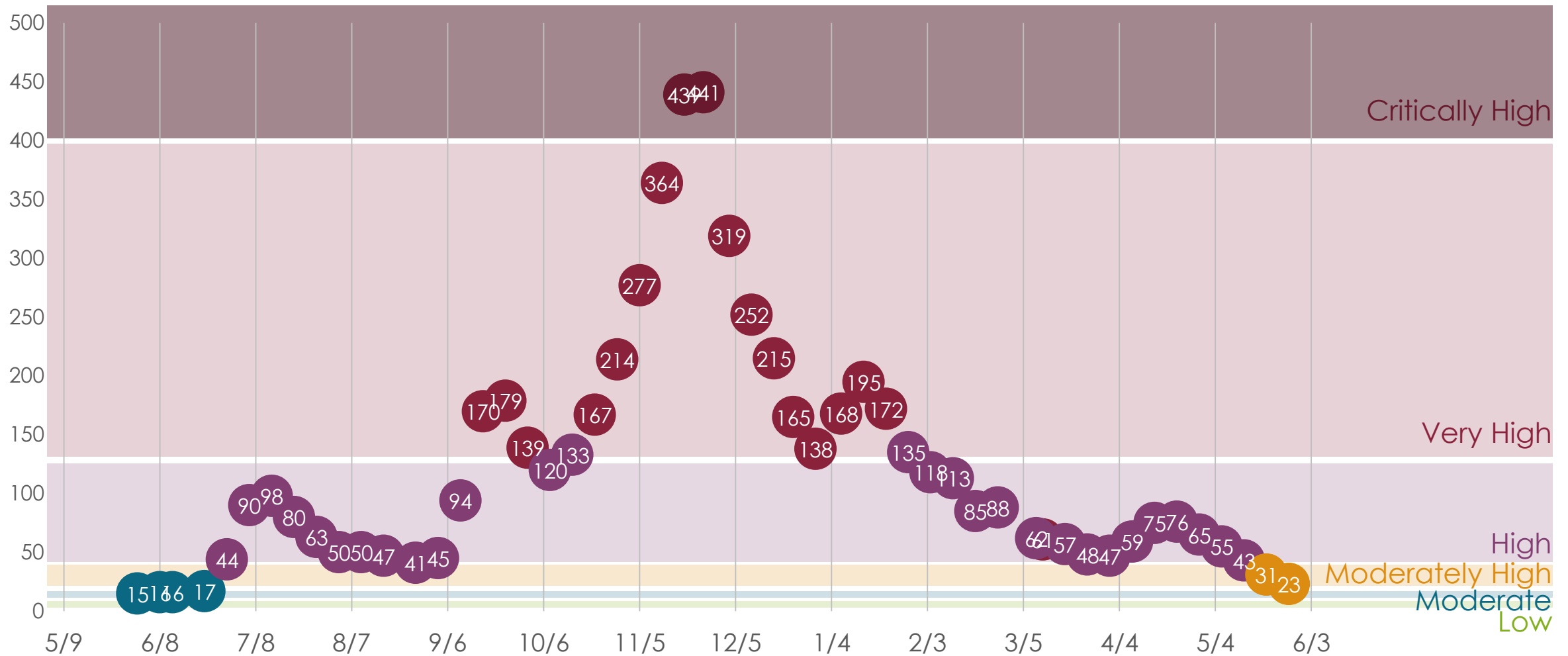
# 46,100+ people have tested positive for COVID.



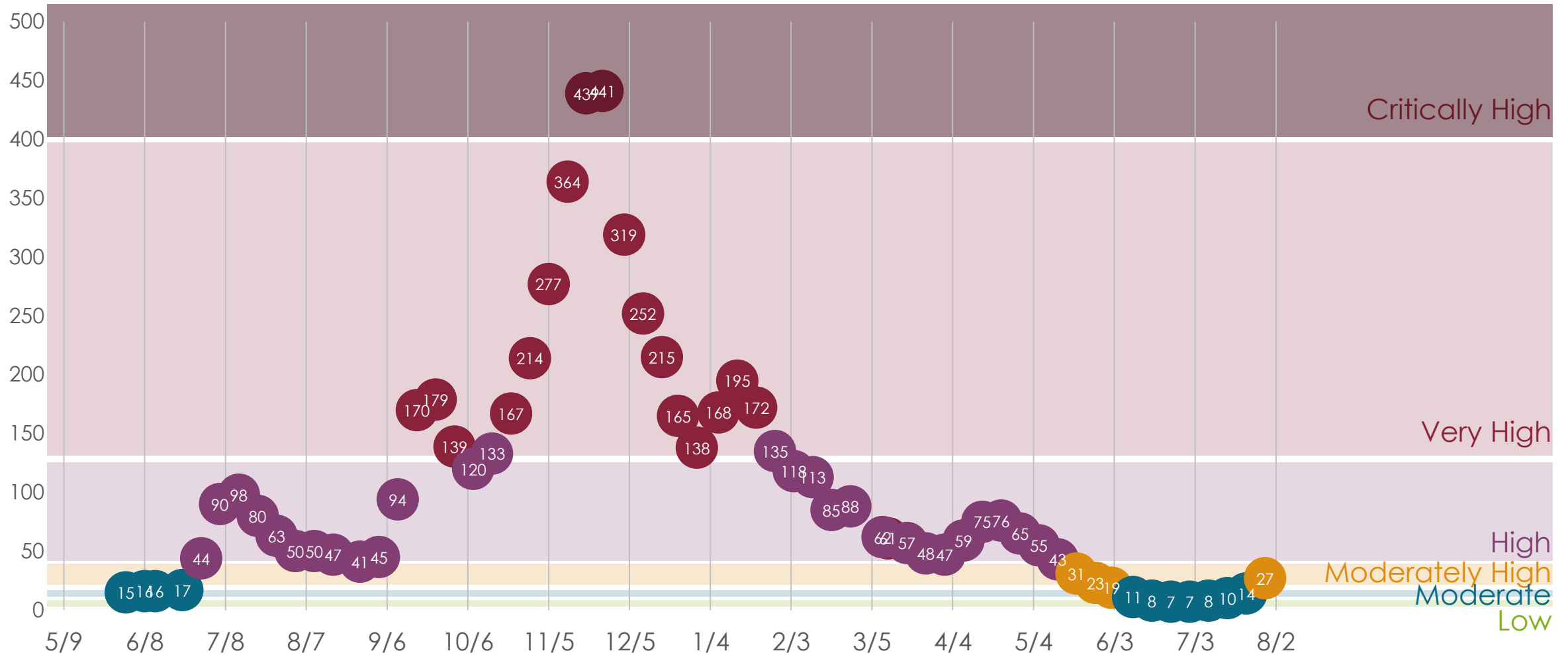
# 81% of our 12+ population has at least one dose of vaccine.



# The last time we met, our 14-day averages looked like this:



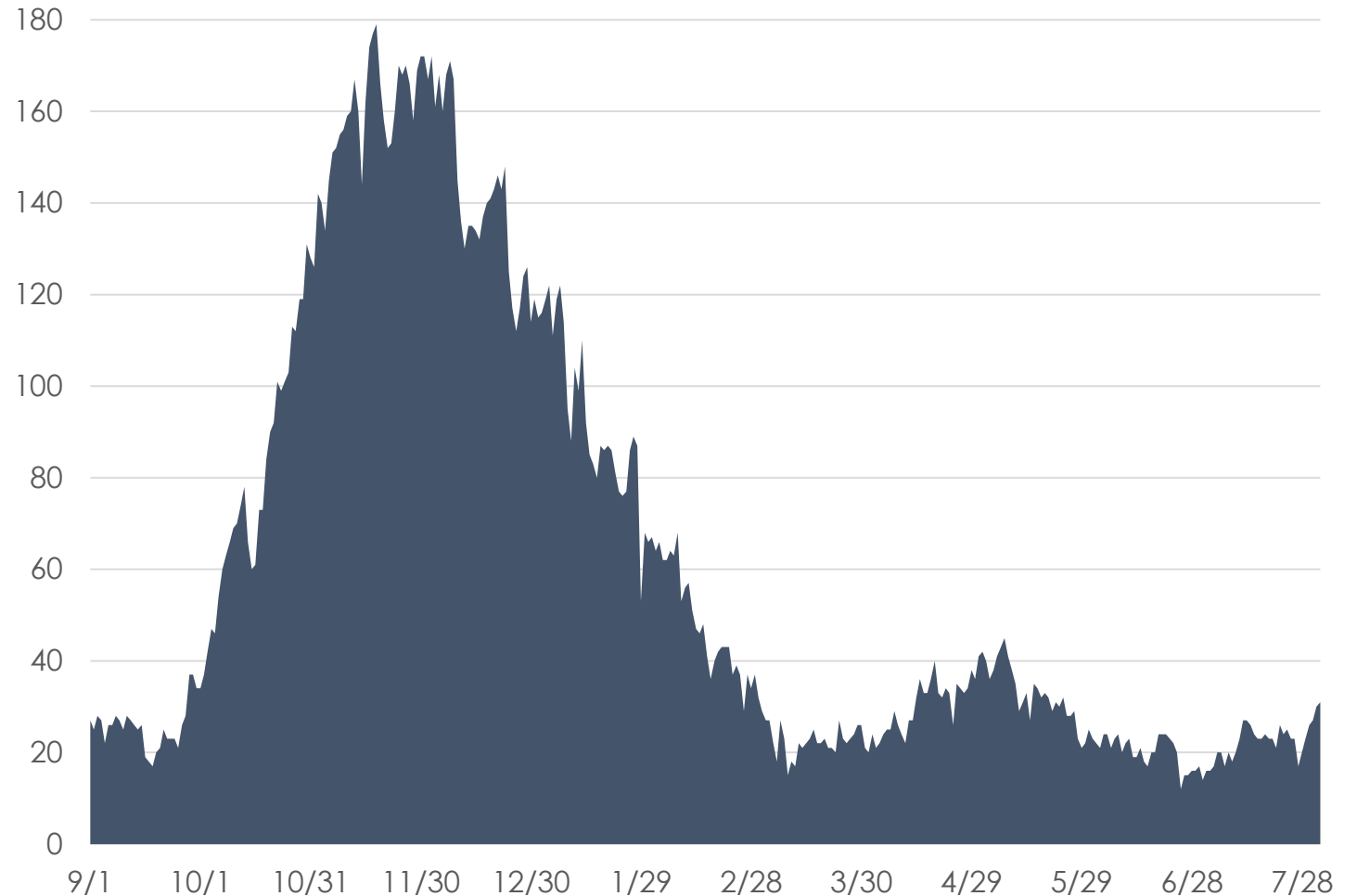
# It now looks like this:



# Hospitalizations

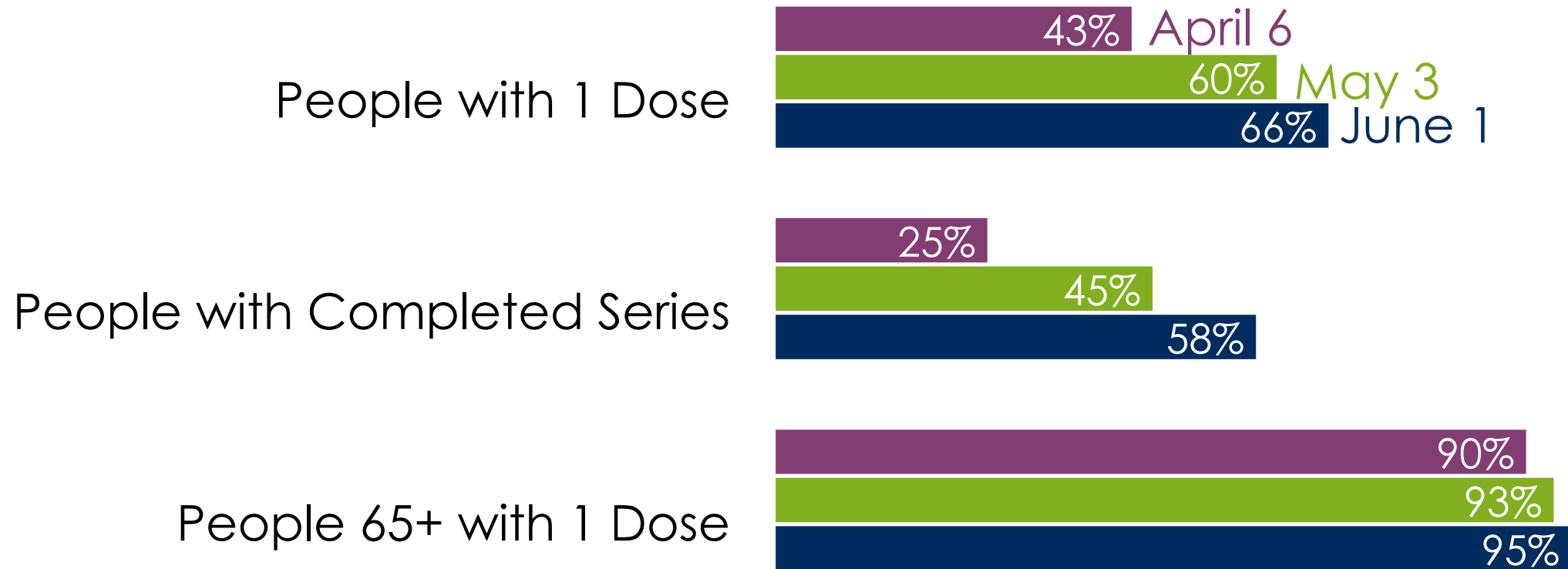
Hospitalizations are still far below where they were in late fall.

Yesterday there were 31 people hospitalized.

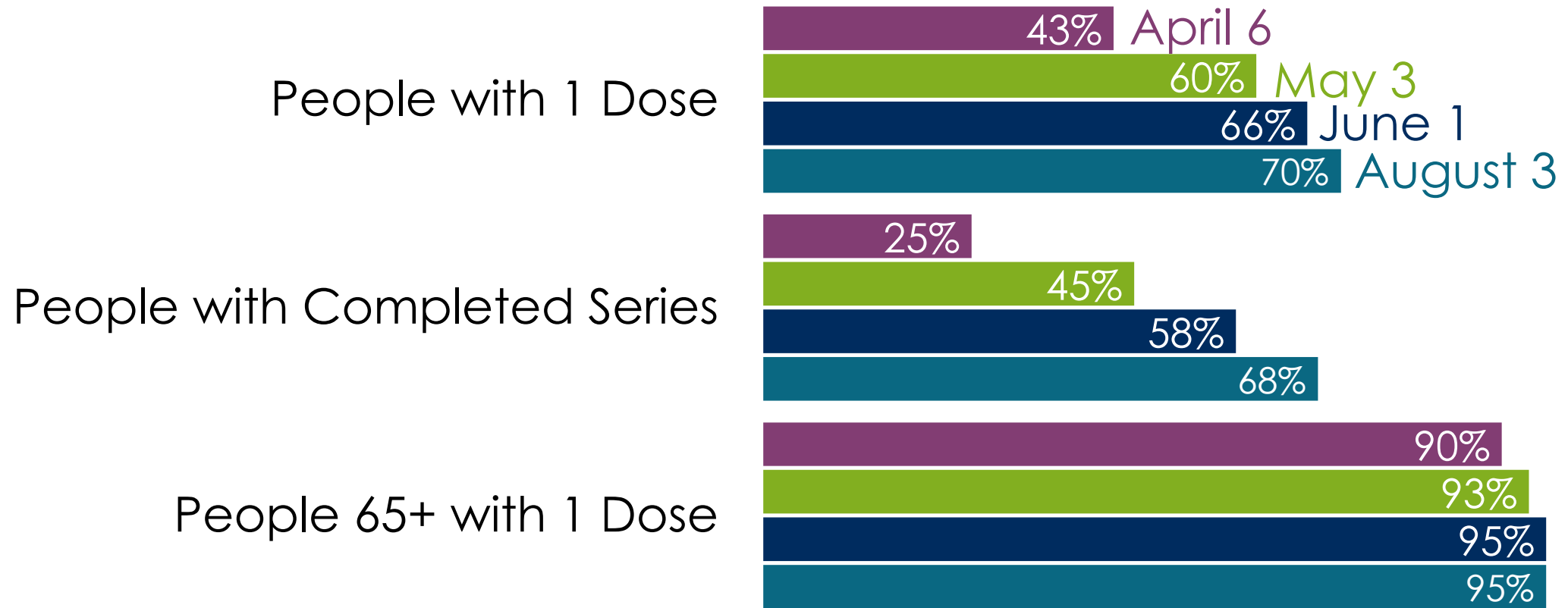

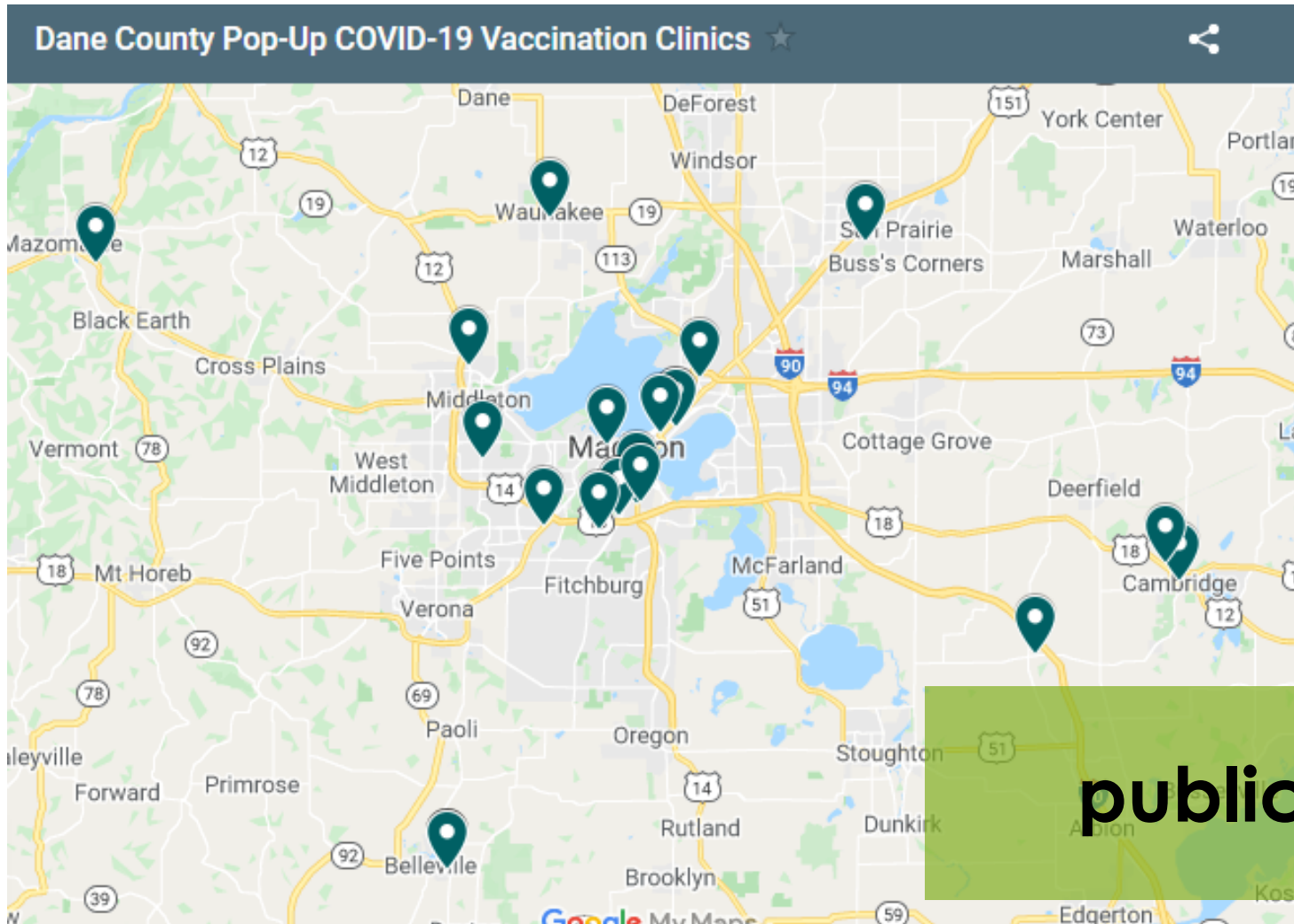
