



2021 Traffic Enforcement Goals

- 4. Responsive to citizen complaints




Traffic Grant Corridors / Temp HIN (DRAFT)








2021 YTD Fatal & Serious Crash Locations








Hazardous vs Non-Hazardous Citations






Traffic Complaints – 2021 City-wide

2021 Q1





E Washington Ave Citations & Warnings


- 10,755 Citations and Warnings issued city-wide as of 8/2/21
 - 1,396 as the result of crash investigations
 - 2,694 as part of grant-funded OT initiatives
 - 2,425 by (5) TEST Officers
- 1,936 Proactive (not crash based)
 Citations and Warnings on E
 Washington Ave YTD
 - 18% of all citations and warnings in 2021 issued city-wide






E Washington Ave Grant-Funded OT Traffic Enforcement Grants

- Total of 150 Grant Deployments
 - 50 on E Washington Ave
 - 33% of all grants



E Washington Ave Traffic Complaints

- 114 Complaints mentioning E Wash
- 19% of all complaints city-wide
