Round 1 of Emergency Rental Assistance funds authorized January 2021

- ❖ City of Madison \$7.7 million allocation
- ❖ Dane County \$8.5 million allocation

- Federal Regulations created barriers like burden on grantee to insure no duplication of benefits; income documentation and restriction of funds use.

- Then 10% eligible for admin and/or housing stability services.

Emergency Rental Assistance funds

- ❖ City of Madison ERA2: \$6.1 million
 - ❖ City of Madison ERA1 from State of WI: \$9.2 million
 - ❖ Dane County ERA2: \$12.6 million
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- City of Madison used admin funds to purchase Neighborly Software, a centralized database system to track the use of Emergency Rental Assistance funds.

EVICTIION DEFENSE PROGRAM

Refer households with a court ordered eviction to Tenant Resource Center.

Tenant Resource Center will refer households to community partners for legal representation:

- ❖ Legal Action of Wisconsin
- ❖ UW Neighborhood Law Clinic
- ❖ Community Justice Inc

Tenant Resource Center can process Dane CORE 2.0 payments for households in the court system in consultation with the legal team.

DANE CORE 2.0- PROGRAM CHANGES

The program has expanded to cover additional housing cost. Eligible households can apply for rental arrears as well as the following financial assistance:

- ❖ Past due housing **utilities** (i.e. water, gas, electric)- telephone and cable not included
- ❖ **Internet Services** (If bundled with telephone and cable a portion of the bill will be covered).
- ❖ **Security Deposits and Future Rent Payments** may be available if any of the following are true:
 - You have an eviction notice, or are at immediate risk of eviction.
 - Your household is Low-Income (less than 50% Area Median Income).
 - You are currently getting Unemployment Insurance benefit payments.
 - You have a notice of non-renewal at your current home.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

- ❖ Tenant and Landlord applications are being migrated to the new system. People with pending applications do NOT need to re-apply;
- ❖ Payments have started going out to City of Madison landlords as of Monday Sept 27th again;
- ❖ Migration of data/applications should be completed by October 1st;
- ❖ A large relaunch of the application website, phone number and availability of program will start October 1st;
- ❖ There will be ONE phone number to access the program and ONE application link;
- ❖ Urban Triage will start processing applications October 4th.
