Sorry about the delay. Could you put this map in legistar with the points I have raised and please feel free to make tweeks to encompass the essence of my reasoning for such a map. This is the reasoning for proposing these maps.

In District 17, the Autumn Lake neighborhood and the Ridgewood neighborhood have historically shared the East Town as community of interest. This historical community of interest should remain the same

In District 4 the numbers are still low. I would like to see State street remai and any blocks by W. Gorham or W. Gilman added onto State street to increase the number to 5% allowance.

In District 14. Historically, Arbor Hills has been in and shares commonalities with the other Beltline Highway/12&18 neighborhoods. Therefore, I am proposing the following.

Changing the border to South Park Street and Wingra Creek
District 14 will encompass South Park Street east, neighborhoods across the Beltline
to Bridge Road. This will create a Beltline District. The community interest of all these
areas are the Beltline, ethnic/racial diversity.

District 13 will encompass South Park Street (west), Arboretum/Lost City and Burr Oaks to Fish Hatchery Road. Thus creating the Wingra Watershed District. The community interest of all these areas are the watershed. In addition, this proposal creates ethnic/racial diversity in District 13.
