Polling Place Requirements

- 1. Welcoming to all voters.
- 2. Location within or near ward that is easily accessed.
- 3. Large enough to accommodate the number of voters anticipated.
- 4. Interior space assigned allows for smooth flow of movement of voters from one station to another as they complete the process.
- 5. Handicap accessibility requirements met, such as adequate width of doorways and halls, as well as space to maneuver in a wheelchair around the voting area.
- 6. Doors to building and to voting area are opened for election officials at 6 a.m., and remain open to the public from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on election days.
- 7. Tables and chairs are available for election officials to move and use as needed to accommodate tasks.
- 8. A locked space for storage of election equipment from the delivery date (1-5 days prior to the election) through 6 a.m. Election Day, and at the end of Election Day through the time it is picked up on the days following the election (for the Tabulator and accessible voting machines). Also a space to store folded booths and signage (usually in the back of a closet, etc.). [This is not required, it just helps us.]
