How can I get a library card?

Apply for a library card at any Madison library or online at <u>Individual Library Card Form | MPLnet</u>. You'll need to fill out an application form, <u>and bring</u> provide photo I.D. AND proof of current <u>residence</u> address. Online proof of address is acceptable.

A driver's license with current address is the easiest way to apply. If you do not have that, we will accept a photo ID plus:

- •checkbook with name and current address printed on it or
- •a piece of current mail IF the envelope has your name, current address and a postmark dated within the last 30 days or-
- •a current lease with your name and address on it -or-
- •a current utility bill or bank statement.

If your identification has a P.O. Box or business addresses, you still must show do not qualify as proof of your current home address.

What if I don't have proof of address?
