The Dane County Regional Airport proposes to demolish all buildings, foundations, pavement, dead trees and stumps and debris and cap and abandon all utilities within the parcel limits located at 2402 Darwin Rd., Madison, WI 53704. No work will occur outside of the parcel limits. The work is anticipated to occur sometime between January 1 and May 31, 2022. Once started, the work will be completed in 30 consecutive calendar days.

The work will be performed by a qualified contractor under contract with the Airport and the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation Bureau of Aeronautics. The contractor is responsible for coordinating the utility work (capping and abandoning) with the utility companies and obtaining the demolition permit from City of Madison Building Inspection. Prior to commencing construction activities, silt fence will be installed around the limits of disturbance. Building foundations will be removed in their entirety and backfilled with granular material, as well as removed pavement sections. Dead trees will be cleared and grubbed. The disturbed areas within the site will be restored with topsoil, seed, fertilizer and erosion mat. Any and all hazardous materials will be properly remediated prior to building demolition.

The existing site conditions are one (1) single-family house; (1) auxiliary building (garage); (1) mobile home; asphalt driveway; concrete parking ramp, sidewalk, stoops and other miscellaneous concrete; and miscellaneous debris. Currently, there is no intended use for the parcel following the demolition.
