

Commercial building constructed in 1922 with additions in 1950 and 1953, and the retail portion remodeled in 1975. The building proposed for demolition is the shop portion of the building, constructed in 1950 and remodeled in 1954, located on the northwest corner of the structure.

Applicant's Comments: The proposed is a partial demolition of the building at the northwest corner of 1124 Regent St.
Portions of the existing building to be demolished include the exterior walls, interior partitions, roof deck, and mechanical systems. The steel columns, beams, and trusses will remain to define a new outdoor patio.
Staff Findings: A preservation file for this property does not exist. There is no site file with the Wisconsin Historical Society. The City Assessor property record notes that there are three Trachte sheds on the property.
