Fey also described the Charter and Reporting documents that will be utilized to maintain focus on the topics & questions identified by the Task Force.

Chair Fey reported that the Regional Agriculture & Food Sovereignty Work Group of the Madison Food Policy Council has requested adding the issue of "farmland loss" to the list of Topics and will explore with Planning staff how this might be mapped within the City, perhaps by searching for parcels that were rezoned from "ag and temporary ag" to development in the last 20 years. This issue will be added to the Categorized List of Topics and Questions.

- Land Characteristics: Caton Campbell, Paulson, LeZaks
