#### **CLOSED SESSION**

A motion was made by Gundlach, seconded by Schauf, to Convene into Closed Session. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

The commissioners convened into closed session at 12:04pm.

1. <u>82041</u> The Commission may convene into closed session, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §

19.85(1)(a) (deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of a quasi-judicial hearing before the governmental body) and Wis. Stat. § 19.85(1)(c) (considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility); specifically:

to conduct deliberations in the continued Evidentiary Hearing in the Matter of Charges brought by Police Chief Shon F. Barnes, Complainant v. Sergeant Nicholas Ellis, Respondent.

Deliberations occurred in closed session.

2. <u>82042</u> Reconvene into open session to consider any remaining agenda items and to take action, if appropriate, regarding the items discussed in closed session

#### Vote on matters discussed in closed session

A motion was made by Greer, seconded by Figueroa Velez, to find that the Respondent, Nicholas Ellis, violated the Madison Police Department's Conduct of Conduct regarding Unlawful Conduct, pursuant to the seven (7) just cause factors, and that there is just cause to impose the discipline of reduction in rank from Sergeant to Police Officer, effective immediately upon filing of the Board's Order.

The motion passed by voice vote/other.

President Greer noted that, consistent with the statute, the Board's written decision and order will be filed within 3 days.
