## **ITEMS CONSIDERED**

1. <u>13648</u> Authorizing the Mayor, City Clerk, and the Director of the Department of Civil Rights to enter into a contract with the U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission to provide complaint processing services during Federal fiscal year 2009 with option periods for Federal fiscal years 2010 and 2011.

A motion was made by Bruer, seconded by Clear, to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT - REPORT OF OFFICER. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

2. <u>14918</u> Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into an agreement with Edgewood College for the provision of free access by Edgewood students and employees to Metro Transit for fixed route and ADA paratransit services, with reimbursement per trip for the contract period.

A motion was made by Bruer, seconded by Clear, to Return to Lead with the Recommendation for Approval to the TRANSIT AND PARKING COMMISSION. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

3. <u>14606</u> Approve satisfying six existing mortgages and promissory notes in the amount of \$127,956.50 that represent CDBG Office financed improvements at 101 E. Mifflin, create a new mortgage and promissory note for a combined \$377,956.50 to reflect the value of the old notes and the new \$250,000 loan approved by the CDBG Commission on 1/6/2009; and approve a waiver of the 2009-10 Program Funding Framework to reflect no shared appreciation on the new note.
