APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Wagner, seconded by Rummel, to Approve the Minutes for the meeting of August 5, 2009. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

PUBLIC COMMENT

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. <u>11810</u>

1127, 1291 North Sherman Avenue - Clarification of Planned Commercial Site's Comprehensive Design Review Sign Plan. 12th Ald. Dist.

The original motion by Slayton, seconded by Weber, to grant final approval based on the signage being approved for a maximum of seven (7) years; if lease changes or new tenancy prior to the end of the seven year period the sign shall be removed and replaced, was amended on a motion by Ferm, seconded by Wagner, to allow for the sign's use by the daycare tenant and daycare tenant only, with its removal upon termination or change of occupancy was approved as an amendment to the original motion on a vote of (9-0). The original motion was then passed on a vote of (9-0). Compliance with night sky lighting and full shielding was also required.

A motion was made by Slayton, seconded by Weber, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

2. <u>13295</u>

2 South Bedford Street - PUD(GDP-SIP), Mixed-Use Development. 4th Ald. Dist.

The motion for final approval noted the need for adding a railing and/or bollard feature or other alternative safety feature as discussed in order to prevent people from walking directly into the drive aisle beneath the canopy.

A motion was made by Harrington, seconded by Luskin, to Grant Final Approval. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

Relevant to the modifications to the plan to accommodate the CVS Pharmacy drive-up, on a motion by Slayton, seconded by Ferm, the Urban Design Commission Granted Final Approval. The motion was passed on a vote of (8-1) with Luskin voting no.
