#### Report of the Subcommittee on Downtown Alcohol Issues & Ordinances

17.19841Final report from the Subcommittee on Downtown Alcohol Issues and<br/>Ordinances.

Testimony was heard from several registrants, with the committee asking questions. Alcohol Policy Coordinator Woulf suggested an extension of the sunset date to allow proper review of proposed changes by the appropriate committees. The committee agreed on a July 5, 2011 sunset. Alders Bidar-Sielaff and Verveer asked the Assistant City Attorney to draft a motion to this effect for them to introduce at the next meeting of the Common Council.

Dr. Bean recommended corrections to the document, item 5 (a)(iv)- a Class A establishment cannot be an entertainment venue.

The committee also agreed that the window for replacing a class A or class B establishment within the Density area should be 730 days. The 730 day limit is not a guarantee that an establishment applying within that timeframe will be approved by the committee.
