### ZONING CODE REWRITE

**15932** Adopting and confirming amendments to the Madison General Ordinances as set forth in attached Exhibit F pursuant to Sec. 66.0103, Wis. Stats. to revise the City's Zoning Ordinance.

Fey recommended a process for identifying "referrals" and items for "future after adoption". She provided an overview of the "Summary of Plan Commission Special Meeting Refer and Future Items" memorandum.

Discussion and action on Memorandum 1: Committee and Commission Recommendations and Comments received on the City of Madison draft zoning code (Legistar 15932)

Discussion of Lakefront Property Considerations Staff Memorandum

Staff provided an overview of the memorandum.

Commission discussed the memorandum.

Motion by Bowser to recommend Alternative B, including provisions 1 and 2. Second by Sundquist

Amendment to the Motion, moved by Sundquist, to add to Alternative B a clause stating that "in no case shall a principal building be located closer to the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM) than 75 feet." Second by Olson. Amendment Passed (Ayes-Sundquist, Basford, Gruber, Bowser, Olson, Andrzejewski. Noes-Heifetz)

Amendment to the Motion, moved by Gruber, to add to Alternative B language to allow additions and expansions of existing buildings to utilize the current setback (Lakefront Staff Memo Alternative C 4th bullet). Second by Basford. Amendment Passed (Ayes-Sundquist, Basford, Gruber, Bowser, Olson, Andrzejewski. Noes-Heifetz)

Amendment to the Motion, moved by Sundquist, to remove from Alternative B the exemption for civic and institutional uses. Second by Basford. Amendment Passed by voice vote/other

Amendment to the Motion, moved by Sundquist, to add to Alternative B the lot coverage standards as described in the Lakefront Staff Memo. Amendment to the amendment, moved by Gruber to specify a maximum of 20% lot coverage within 35 feet of the OHWM, and exempt public paths. Second by Bowser. Amendment Passed (Ayes-Sundquist, Basford, Gruber, Bowser, Olson. Noes-Heifetz, Andrzejewski)

Main Motion- For non-residential lakefront development, recommend Alternative B, setback averaging, with the following modifications: the lakefront setback for new development shall be not less than 75 feet, or the setback of the existing building, in the case of additions, alterations, and expansions; civic and institutional uses are no longer exempted from this review; lot coverage within 35 feet of the OHWM may not exceed 20%, with an exemption for public paths. Motion Passed (Ayes-Sundquist, Basford, Gruber, Bowser, Olson, Andrzejewski. Noes-Heifetz)

Motion by Gruber to add statement of purpose per page 6 of the Lakefront Staff Memo. Second by Sundquist.

Amendment by Olson to add word "viewsheds" to the list of things being protected. Second by Bowser. Amendment Passed by voice vote/other. Motion Passed by voice vote/other.

Motion by Sundquist to place on the "future" list vegetation removal and replacement standards. Second by Basford. Motion passed by voice vote/other.

Motion by Basford to accept staff response on Page 42 #44 (Memo 1). Second by Bowser. Motion passed by voice vote/other.

Motion by Sundquist to extend the lot coverage standard that was approved earlier in the meeting to residential properties (20% lot coverage within 35 feet of the OHWM with an exemption for public paths). Second by Bowser. Motion passed. Ayes- Sundquist, Gruber, Basford, Olson, Bowser . Noes-Andrzejewski, Heifetz.

Motion by Sundquist that 25 foot setback applies to single-family and two-family but 75 feet applies to multi-family (three or more units). Second by Basford. Motion passed. Ayes-- Sundquist, Gruber, Basford, Olson, Bowser, Andrzejewski. Noes- Heifetz.

Motion by Sundquist that multi-family development be governed by the same standards passed for non-residential development. Second by Bowser. Motion passed. Ayes--Sundquist, Gruber, Basford, Olson, Bowser, Andrzejewski. Noes- Heifetz.

Motion by Andrzejewski to reconsider vegetative standards. Second by Bowser. Motion passed by voice vote/other.

Heifetz left meeting at 7:15 p.m.

Motion by Sundquist to refer the mention of erosion control within the vegetative standards section to be discussed before Plan Commission makes a final recommendation to the Council. Second by Gruber. Motion Passed by voice vote/other.
