The Chair made the following statement: The Chairs of the Plan Commission, Urban Design Commission and Landmarks Commission were invited to meet with the Director of Planning and the Planning Division Director. Wagner did not attend as he was ill. Wagner spoke to Stu Levitan who did attend and it was to discuss a potential reorganization of the Planning Division. One of the consequences would be that the long-time staff member of this Commission would no longer staff this Commission, along with other potential changes as well. Wagner felt very strongly that the kind of professional and extremely competent staff they've had through AI is something this Commission has really appreciated. He brings a depth of knowledge to how this Commission has worked and the issues of planning in the City that is invaluable to this operation. He understands the Mayor has put this particular reorganization on hold; it is his hope that it stays on hold for guite awhile. Goodhart added as a sometime applicant that AI Martin's guidance and experience really helps the project before it even gets to this body. Cnare inquired if Chair Wagner would be comfortable sending a letter on behalf of the Commission.
