31326 Discussion of International Disability Rights Issues

The commission was addressed by Nishantha Kumara, a fellow with the International Reasearch and Exchange Board (IREX) currently working at Access to Independence. Mr Kumara is here as part of an exchange program to learn about disability rights policies and practices in order to develop a support network in his home country of Sri Lanka. Mr Kumara noted that Sri Lanka has a population of 21 million, 7% of which is comprised of people with diosabilities. Currently the country is focused on economic development but lacks the infrastructure for accesibility. Mr Kumara hopes to return to Sri Lanka inorder to develop a network similar to independent living cetners in america. The commission shared some of their insight with Mr Kumara regarding independent living philosophy as well as steps and methods to building and fostering a disability rights movement.
