2. <u>33999</u> Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk to execute agreements with current and future municipalities, institutions, and organizations, including but not limited to the Cities of Middleton, Fitchburg and Verona, the Town of Madison, the University of Wisconsin-Madison, Madison College, and Madison Metropolitan School District for provision of transit service benefiting these partner municipalities, institutions and organizations starting January 1, 2015 for current partners and upon execution for future partners and continuing until written notice of termination or amendment by either party.
