# 12. 27918 ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DIVISION - 5 minutes

The end of licensing year is 6-30, staff are busy finishing inspections. Sanitarian workload assignments take effect July 1, including more specialization.

The division is hiring an Environmental Tech whose duties will include low risk food.

Kipp work on rain garden wrapped up removed contaminated soils; discovered another PCB hot spot found which requires clean up.

Construction increasing so well and septic permits coming.

A group of interested community partners are working on a package of animal ordinances to help in several areas.

The Lab is busy with the first blue green algae bloom and nitrate concentration work.

# 13. 32731 COMMUNITY HEALTH DIVISION - 5 minutes

Program evaluation is being done across the department and how to measure performance. Our four priority populations; maternal child health and early childhood, Latina health, LGBT and aging.

We have nice relationships with primary care providers, resulting in more coordinated approaches to public health.

The department is hosting 17 students, committing more time and resource to our workforce.
