Scenarios looked at transportation emission reductions using options like Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) but overall impacts on Green House Gases (GHG) seemed to be minimal. The group identified 8 metrics that should be tracked to see if we can reach that target. Upgrading the City's building standards seemed to be the most cost effective way to impact GHG emissions.
