1. <u>39254</u> Report from the Madison Fire Department, Assistant Fire Chief Langer

2. <u>39255</u> Report from the Madison Police Department, Captain Ackeret

Report from Captain Ackeret:

•A copy of the 7/14/2015 Chief's blog was distributed and comments on the progress made during the previous year.

•MPD management is reviewing the recommendations made in the May 2015 released report by the President's Task Force on 21st Century Policing. The MPD status in terms of the recommendations will be reviewed and posted on

the MPD website in the next few months. Here is the link to the Task Force report; tp://www.cops.usdoj.gov/pdf/taskforce/TaskForce_FinalReport.pdf •Pickett asked about receiving monthly reports on the use of the MPD Armored Rescue Vehicle (ARV). A report was previously requested by Alder Strasser and provided to the committee. A monthly report will be provided to the committee.

•Pickett inquired about status of a report detailing 2015 gun violence that was previously requested by Alder Cheeks. The report will be provided to the committee at the August meeting.

•Alder McKinney inquired about Alder notification of significant incidents within the district and noted she was not notified of a bike fatal crash that occurred last month. MPD Commanders are expected to make Alder notifications when significant incidents occur.

•Horinek noted some issues in the Raymond Rd/ Meadow Wood area, particularly with some less than responsible landlords. There was some discussion about police/landlord relationships and roles. Landlords can access information on police calls for service to their properties through the MPD records sections or https://www.crimereports.com/

•The committee is awaiting an update to the City Nuisance Ordinance that is being worked on by Assistant City Attorney Zilavy.

•The Mayor's Police Policy ad hoc committee has received a number of applicants that are currently being reviewed and it is anticipated the committee appointments will be made "soon".
