 - A motion was made by Gassere, seconded by Hackett with amendments shown below, to approve the handout titled, "UPDATED 7-8-15 DRAFT Proposed Changes Public Review Draft Emerson East-Eken Park-Yahara Neighborhood Plan", additional changes included in the July 8, 2015 minutes, and changes made at today's meeting.
 - The following amendments to the motion were proposed by Hackett:
 - Focus Area Four Pg. 35, #13: change "Yahara Park" to "Tenney Park".
 - CDRC table
 - Move #2 Emerson East Neighborhood, Tiny Houses, to the last item of the list (priority #7) and add "with consent of Occupy Madison".
 - The following additional amendment was proposed by Grubb:
 - Focus Area Five Pg. 26, Connectivity: move existing bus stops and other Metro
 Transit amenities to Fordem Avenue <u>accommodating the needs of businesses</u>, pedestrians and bicyclists, and design the new intersection to
 accommodate bus traffic and other larger vehicles, while also accommodating

pedestrians and bicyclists safely.

- The following amendment to the amendment made by Grubb was proposed by Hackett:
 - Focus Area Five Pg. 26, Connectivity: move existing bus stops and other Metro Transit amenities to Fordem Avenue <u>accommodating the needs of businesses</u>, pedestrians and bicyclists, <u>and including any Bus Rapid Transit system</u>, and design the new intersection to accommodate bus traffic and other larger vehicles, while also accommodating pedestrians and bicyclists safely.

- Final Draft Plan presentation to City Committees, Commissions and Boards
 - The Steering Committee members will share the responsibility of presenting the plan. A proposed presentation schedule will be circulated and members may sign up accordingly.
- Plan Implementation
 - Steering Committee members are encouraged to participate in plan implementation through neighborhood groups and other community organizations.
 - The Planning Division will work with other City agencies over time on completion of City led implementation.
