Repealing Section 33.12 and amending Section 33.52 of the Madison General Ordinances to eliminate the Committee on Community Gardens.

In addition to authorizing the elimination of the Committee on Community Gardens, this ordinance amends the roster of the Madison Food Policy Council to specify a representative or advocate of community gardens. Committee members asked that its materials and presence on the City's website be retained and that the Ordinance and Resolution be on its final meeting agenda December 6th for an update on the completion of the legislative process.

44880 Sheboygan Gardens Update OCTOBER 2016

Report on Sheboygan Avenue Community Gardens relocation. George Reistad met with City staff from Parks, Engineering, Water, Planning, EDD, and Mayor's Office who mentioned that during Alder Schmidt's term, there was quite a bit of work and research that went into locating alternative sites within the Hill Farms area.

Working to gather and compile this info and will then set another meeting, which department heads will provide designated staffers to start assessing sites and creating a report – per Nan's timeline we hope to have something ready or almost ready by Thanksgiving so this can be acted on before the end of the year and the presumed dissolution of this committee. Committee expressed frustration that the process is just beginning now, given the passage of the Resolution in May and the October 1st due date for the first stage of the process report.
