Discussion centered around residents seeing a need for sidewalk on north side of street for nearby school and pedestrians. Bachmann said from public informational meetings, the neighborhood and Alder Cheeks seem supportive of sidewalk on the north side. She said that Traffic Engineering has not had input on crossing Chippewa to access south sidewalk. Bachmann said it could be an option to split the project by going forward with the north side at this time and then assess the south side sidewalk. Resident's concerns about width of terrace was also discussed. A motion was made by Ald. Clear, seconded by Johnson to Recommend to Council to RECOMMEND TO COUNCIL TO ADOPT UNDER SUSPENSION OF RULES 2.04, 2.05, 2.24 & 2.25 - PUBLIC HEARING.
