1. <u>23110</u> Endorsing Community Projects

Commissioners reviewed the proposed public art "Waterfall" project at 316 West Washington Avenue, a large-scale sculpture that will afix to the front facade of the building.

A motion was made by Tvedt, seconded by Pino, to recommend UDC Approve the project. The motion passed by voice vote/other.

2. <u>27011</u> Art in Public Places

A motion was made by Pino, seconded by Foy, to Approve an additional \$10,000 from the Capital Public Art Fund to support "Shift" a public art project that will be installed at the underpass at Highland Avenue. The motion passed by voice vote/other.
