The motion passed by a voice vote.

2. <u>07804</u> Secretary's Report

Rummel explained her concern about windows and the recent and upcoming loss of window expertise on the Landmarks Commission. She explained that she would like a way to protect the historic material. Attorney Strange examined the issue, provided an alternate solution, and will draft a memo. The issue should be added to a future meeting for further discussion.

3. <u>45700</u> Buildings Proposed for Demolition - 2017

A motion was made by Gehrig and seconded by Rummel to recommend to the Plan Commission that the Landmarks Commission finds that the buildings at 711, 717, and 727 East Johnson Street collectively have historic value that contributes to the larger vernacular context of Madison's built environment, but the buildings themselves are not known to have historic, architectural or cultural significance. The motion passed via voice vote.

By unanimous consent, the Landmarks Commission found that the buildings at 3922 and 3926 Mineral Point Road have no known historic value.
