Chief Administrative Officer Robin Piper and Finance Supervisor Kathy Schwenn addressed the board.

Board members suggested changes to the reports they received, including:

- · A "dashboard" with revenue and other criticial financial numbers
- A report with revenue and expenses vs. budget
- Information re: assumptions and calculations made for revenue projections.
- Annual comparisons including at least two prior years to show trends
- Greater detail in the operating budget

Board members also suggested the following:

- For budgeting purposes, rate increases should not be factored into revenue projections unless a rate order is in hand.
- Anticipated weather conditions and water conservation trends should be factored into revenue projections.
- Water Utility Board approval of property sales--with a report from engineering staff for future well and facility sites that are sold
- · Consideration of a hiring freeze
- Reconsideration of Water Conservation House project including costs to rent property.

Further discussion of the Water Utility Board's role in rate increase calculations was suggested as a future agenda item.

A motion was made by Gotkowitz, seconded by Delmmore, requesting that staff prepare an addendum to the memo addressing the above requests. The motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
